Must be on time! (Flags are available at all Marion County Shops)** Area to be sprayed must be flagged at each end for entire season. If flags are not visible driver will use own judgment for location. **PLEASE NOTE: All spots are measured and any footage flagged over ordered amount will be billed to customer.** If you are not sure of flag distance and do not want more than ordered please write it on the permit so you will not get billed for extra footage.

Responsibilities of Customer

1. Shall follow deadlines established for requesting dust control. No exceptions.
2. **Shall place yellow flags available from supplier or the Secondary Road Department at each end of area to be treated so as to be readily visible to maintainer operators. Flags are to be placed no later than April 12 and maintained by the customer until Oct. 15.** Flags not being in place could result in the dust control area being disturbed. In such cases the customer is responsible for any reapplication necessary.
3. Shall be responsible for maintaining the dust control area by filling potholes that may develop as soon as possible, and within three days if notified by Marion County. Loose material from the edge of the road may be used to fill potholes. If not properly maintained, the County reserves the right to smooth and maintain at their discretion.
4. Shall understand that after Oct. 1 of each year, dust control areas are routinely bladed as a normal preparation for winter. Dust control area may also be maintained at any time deemed necessary for the convenience of travelers on the public road. Marion County will not be responsible for the loss of effectiveness of the dust control treatment. In such cases the individual paying for the dust control may have the dust control reapplied at any time.
5. Shall assume full responsibility for any and all liability resulting from the dust control material placed upon the county roadway.
6. Shall understand that by purchasing the dust control service, the customer agrees to abide by the conditions stated in this document.
7. Shall understand that any complaints regarding the performance of the dust control product shall be directed to the applicator, not to Marion County.
