IF MAHASKA COUNTY MAINTAINS YOUR ROAD **YOU NEED TO SIGNUP FOR YOUR DUST CONTROL AT THE MAHASKA COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE. FIRST ROUND CUT-OFF IS APRIL 14, 2017. SECOND ROUND CUT-OFF IS JUNE 2, 2017. SECOND APPLICATION IS JULY 28, 2017. WEATHER PERMITTING.**

THE COUNTY WILL THEN SEND US A LIST OF APPLICANTS THAT REQUEST OUR SERVICES. DUST CONTROL CANNOT BE APPLIED ON A COUNTY MAINTAINED ROAD WITHOUT A PERMIT.

**DUE TO WEATHER, ROAD, & TRAFFIC CONDITIONS 2 APPLICATIONS ARE RECOMMENDED**

**A MINIMUM LENGTH OF 400' IS REQUIRED**

EAST.** IF FLAGS ARE NOT VISIBLE DRIVERS WILL USE THEIR OWN JUDGMENT FOR LOCATION. **PLEASE NOTE:** ALL SPOTS WILL BE MEASURED. ANY FOOTAGE FLAGGED OVER AMOUNT ORDERED WILL BE BILLED TO CUSTOMER. IF YOU ARE NOT SURE OF FLAG DISTANCE AND DO NOT WANT MORE THAN ORDERED PLEASE LET US KNOW.

## **MAHASKA COUNTY GUIDELINES**

1. Petroleum products and used oil are not allowed.
2. Width of application must be at least 20 feet wide.
3. **Permit applicant is responsible for placing and maintaining Flags as well as "DUST CONTROL" signs at each end of the treated surface. "DO NOT BLADE" signs must be removed and replaced with "DUST CONTROL" signs. If not removed, the County will remove the signs.**
4. **Applicant is responsible for potholes. The County reserves the right to blade the road at any time and is not responsible for lost dust control.**
5. The permit is valid until October 1, 2017, after that date, Mahaska County will blade or rock the road as needed for winter preparation.
6. Mahaska County has no obligation and will assume no responsibility for the dust control product or application. Complaints regarding the performance of the dust control product should be directed to the applicator.

## **MAHASKA COUNTY 2017 DUST CONTROL POLICY**

It is again time for dust control planning for the 2017 season. Completing the Permit Application complies with the Mahaska County Board of Supervisors Resolution on Dust Control dated April 26, 1993, and signals Mahaska County Secondary Roads to prepare the roadway for application of your preferred dust control product. We have enclosed our updated application form for the 2017 season and included a copy of your 2016 permit, **The 2016 copy is for your reference only, please do not return as your 2017 permit.** You **MUST** fill out a new permit for 2017.

All applications must be returned to the Mahaska County Secondary Roads Department Office at 2074 Old Hwy 163 in Oskaloosa. Dust control applications will no longer be accepted at the Supervisor's Courthouse office. The following dates are tentative and subject to change per the County's schedule. However, the County will make every effort to have the roads ready for dust control by these dates. All Applications received by Mahaska County by April 14, 2017, will be available for treatment by your selected applicator May 12, 2017. **If you miss the April 14, 2017 deadline, you WILL NOT be able to get your road treated until June 2nd.** Second applications will not be applied until July 28, 2017.

Mahaska County will forward to your selected applicator notice of your permit application. **You are responsible for contacting the applicator, making payment, and marking each end of the dust control length.** Flags for marking as well as Dust Control signs are available at the Mahaska County Secondary Roads Department office or from your applicators. Flags and Dust Control signs are no longer available at the Supervisor's office in the Courthouse.
